A Chance To Shine

Subject : Physics Level: A level

1) What evidence do you already have that may be used for grading?

Students have already completed various topic tests in year 12. They completed Paper AS Mocks at the end of year 12. The recently completed paper 1 A level papers in the year 13 mock period – we have various assessment marks from during lockdown.

2) What "Chances to shine" are you providing to improve the evidence in 1)?

We will assess the paper 2 content which is everything in the CORE topics which hasn't already been assessed. We will split the 2 hours paper into 3 hours so there is less time constraints.

We will then mark these and feedback to the students – there will be further chances to shine on the same material so there is no new revision needed. Pupils can then see their papers and we will decide If some need to do the paper 1 material to show they can shine.

Students have topic summary booklets – they have been provided with all the end of topic exam questions and answers – they have Kerboodle and lots of assessment material on there.

I will post information on Class Charts for year 13 and post it in their class team page as a reminder (I will post a reminder where to find revision links on Each Friday so there is always a link visible in each classchart window.

5) Will the "chance to shine" task be available remotely? If so, where?

On the day of the opportunity to shine these will be placed onto the class Team page as an assignment which can be completed and submitted within a time window that matches the students completing this in class. For students isolating then these should be completed and submitted as close to the lesson time as possible. Alternatively for short term isolations we can complete the assessment when student returns

6) What form will your portfolio of evidence take and what will it contain?

It will contains the previously completed mock papers and the taken last year. It will also contain the opportunities to shine. It can also include details of performance on assessments from teams completed in lockdown

7) How will you be checking/moderating grades?

Teacher will be marking all the student's work and so will be using the same guidelines to mark these. The marks from all of previous mock exams and these opportunities to shine will be collated and performance can be measures and compared throughout the course.

8) How will you ensure students can see their portfolio of evidence? When will this be?

Pupils can see their key assessment folders after these have been marked.
