### A Chance To Shine

Level A-Level

1) What evidence do you already have that may be used for grading?

- January 'Kitchen Top' assessment
- NEA -coursework

2) What "Chances to shine" are you providing to improve the evidence in 1)?

- Guidance notes given for the NEA – in some cases, these are general comments and some more direct/one to one.
- Chance to Shine in Mid-May with a 45 minute assessment
- Chance to Shine further with NEA after the assessment

3) When will these be and how will you prepare students for them?

- Students have been given an NEA deadline of 30<sup>th</sup> April
- Students have been given a date for Chance to Shine Assessment 17<sup>th</sup> May
- Students will be told the topics for the assessment and revision lessons will take place, in lessons, during time between NEA deadline and the assessment.
- Students will be given feedback on their NEAs after the assessment for a chance to improve further evidence.

4) How will you inform students and parents about specific "Chance to Shine" opportunities?

I have emailed a PowerPoint of these dates to pupils and informed them in lessons. I will email Parents the deadlines too.

5) Will the "chance to shine" task be available remotely? If so, where?

- The Chance to Shine assessment can be accessed remotely, on Teams.
- The NEA is available on pupil's onedrive accounts (three are completing this by hand) and I have links to everyone's NEA so can assess remotely.

6) What form will your portfolio of evidence take and what will it contain?

- Two x mini assessments (Jan 2021 and May 2021)
- One NEA

7) How will you be checking/moderating grades?

AQA have guidance and examples. I am working with another school to undertake some moderating.

8) How will you ensure students can see their portfolio of evidence? When will this be?

- At the end of May, I will inform pupils of their:
  - Chance to Shine assessment raw mark
  - NEA raw mark
  - Reminder of pupil's PPE grade / raw mark
