Evidence that we already have: two NEAs 30% (coursework) and Close Study Products (CSPs) 70% exam practice, Y12 PPE, Y13 interim assessment, end of unit practice exam questions, homework and additional evidence of research and wider reading uploaded to individual folders in Teams in Year 13.

In Term 5 we will be setting in class tasks from the two of the exam papers that students would have sat. Students will know the focus of the essay question the lesson before we do the question in class. Students will then have the opportunity to revise and plan in advance of answering the question.
