Component 2 Chance to Shine classwork – 4/5/2021. Students to be prepared by reteaching relevant content and completing practice questions with guidance.

Coursework improvement will take place during lessons from 20/4/2021 to 17/5/2021. Students to be guided through the mark scheme so they are aware of how to improve the quality of their work.

Students to be told in lessons, dates added to central spreadsheets. Test dates and coursework deadlines to be put on classcharts.
