Unit 1 Coursework started in Year 12. Project SOW has provided all students with the opportunity to access the assessment Objectives set by AQA. This involved a portfolio of evidence at the start of year 12 which was extended into their Independent projects in year 12-13.

Students have provided us with this evidence and grades have been used as a guide as they progressed following the guidance of the exam board.

This has been extended to provide further evidence of AO's set by AQA and will be completed by April 30th.

Further opportunities will be given to the students to add to their portfolios during this time to strengthen their evidence. Tasks will be provided by their teacher based on their individual needs.
