Digital and paper format. Moderator has recently moderated both forms and has been pleased with the level of feedback and grading system being used. Students are fully aware of the process using teams and evidence is supplied in the form of folders and through assignments on Teams.

7) How will you be checking/moderating grades?

Myself and the team of teachers delivering Cambridge Technical Level 3 Sport are all aware of the protocols required to share and feedback pieces of work. Recent moderation visit has highlighted good practice and those sampled were agreed to have followed OCR guidance including links to Employment opportunities. Sampled work following the OCR tracker identifies random students that are cross moderated by the Lead assessor to ensure fairness and consistency.

8) How will you ensure students can see their portfolio of evidence? When will this be?

Students are shown the tracker periodically that identifies which areas of work are outstanding and within lessons teachers encourage students to push boundaries to improve pieces of work for final grading. Pass criteria is prioritized. Teams is used to share pieces of work and students are emailed regularly with guidance and support. This will continue in this form over the remainder of the school year.
