A Chance To Shine

Subject: EPQ

Level: Level 3

1) What evidence do you already have that may be used for grading?

The nature of the EPQ project is such that students have had meetings with supervisors and the students are required to keep an up-to-date log book of planning and meetings.

In addition to this, all Taught Skills sessions have been delivered in person or remotely. Recorded sessions are available on Teams for students to access throughout.

2) What “Chances to shine” are you providing to improve the evidence in 1) ?

Students will have the opportunity in WB19th April to consult with coordinators regarding their EPQ final submission.

As EPQ is an independent project, no resources other than those linked to the Taught Skills element will be shared with students. However, submission of final EPQ project can be emailed or uploaded to Teams.

6) What form will your portfolio of evidence take and what will it contain?

The full EPQ 5000 word essay which is fully referenced/ artefact will provide the evidence for the awarding of the grade for EPQ. This will be complemented by the completed log book entries up to the "End of Project Meeting".

7) How will you be checking/moderating grades?

As Coordinators of the EPQ qualification, EC and LC will mark and moderate the projects accordingly and conduct moderation with reference to the previous EPQ projects (including those completed in November 2021)

8) How will you ensure students can see their portfolio of evidence? When will this be?

Students will retain an electronic copy of the EPQ project that they have completed along with an electronic copy of their log book.
