Mock exam results and end of topic tests from year 10. Deep mark exam questions. NEA teacher assessments completed in year 10 and controlled assessment marks (also completed in year 10)

Final practical exam for NEA component. Opportunity for students offering swimming to be assessed. 2 more exam papers under controlled conditions following extensive revision during lessons.

NEA assessments week beginning 26th April. Paper 1 assessment 5th May and Paper 2 assessment on 11th May. Revision during lessons and preparation for NEA assessments is currently also happening in lessons and students are encouraged to attend extra curricular clubs to supplement this.
