Media Studies GCSE

Year 11 2021 Grade Evidence Collection

Evidence from the beginning of the course / work already marked.

All students present in Year 10 have assessments for the Close Study Products (CSPs) units of work that were studied before the first lockdown in Year 10: Advertising (OMO/Galaxy/NHS), Online Social and Participatory Media (Lara Croft Go/Kim K app/Zoella) and in Year 11, Music Videos (One D + Arctic Monkeys), Film (Dr. Strange + I am Daniel Blake) and Magazines (Reveal + Tatler). The CSPs account for 70% of the Media GCSE.

We have evidence in class practice exam questions from Year 11 and the in-class PPE exam based on units covered.

We will look at work produced for home learning from terms 3 and 4 this year.

e.g. The Magazines Unit assessment and various pieces of additional wider reading and research.

All students have created and NEA (Non-Exam Assessment) which amounts to 30% of their overall grade. This is excellent evidence that all students have now submitted.

Plan for assessments in term 5

To fairly award grades and to make sure all students can produce their best work, the Media team need to carry out four more small assessments:
