### THE BRIEF

CHOOSE A THEME THAT INSPIRES YOU AND TAKE YOUR CAMERA/SKETCHBOOK OUT AND ABOUT WITH YOU OVER THE SUMMER HOLIDAYS. PRODUCE TWO DOUBLE PAGES OF OBSERVATIONS, DOCUMENTING/RECORDING THE DIFFERENT THINGS YOU SEE AND EXPERIENCE.



### CREATE A QUESTION

HERE ARE SOME IDEAS: THE WEATHER - IS IT HOT OR COLD? IS THE SUN OUT? WHAT COLOUR IS THE SKY? IS THERE A BREEZE? COLOURS - NATURAL COLOURS (E.G. SAND/PEBBLES/SEAWEED, CLIFFS/WATER/SKY)? ARTIFICIAL COLOURS (E.G. AMUSEMENTS, LIGHTS, FISHING BOATS) OBJECTS - PEBBLES? DRIFTWOOD, SEA GLASS? CREATURES - IS THERE ANY EVIDENCE OF LIFE? PLANTS (E.G. POND/SEA WEED? REEDS, BEACH PLANTS, LILLIES?) PEOPLE - RATHER THAN LOOKING AT ACTUAL PEOPLE CAN YOU SEE MAN-MADE OBJECTS OR TRACES OF HUMAN LIFE

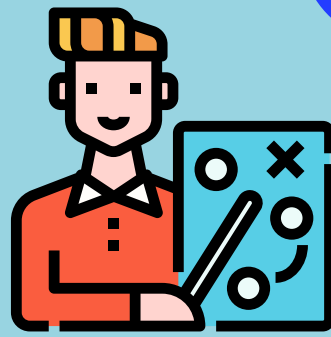

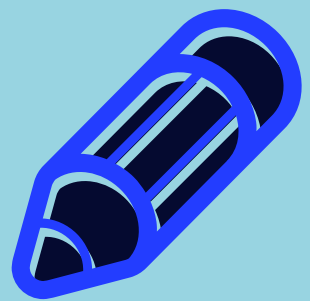
### WHAT TO INCLUDE
